Washington School of Medicine**

Dr. Bill Hammond is board certified in Internal Medicine, Hematology and Medical Oncology and is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians. In his current position, he is working to develop a community-based component to the hematology/oncology fellowship program in the University of Washington's Department of Medicine.

Bill served for six years as President of Minor & James Medical, PLLC, a multi-specialty group in Seattle, now affiliated with Swedish Hospital and Medical Center,

where he practiced for almost 12 years. He was the first President, Medical Director and CEO of the Hope Heart Institute, a cardiovascular research organization founded by Dr. Lester Sauvage.

Bill began his career on the faculty of the University of Washington School of Medicine, where his research focused on the stem cell biology of cyclic neutropenia and the origins of endothelial cells lining blood vessels. He turned to educational efforts, chairing the course on hematology, developing problem-based learning for the second-year curriculum at the School of Medicine and serving as Director of Medical Education for Providence Seattle Medical Center, the University of Washington's primary community teaching hospital.

Currently, Bill is a member of the American Board of Internal Medicine Hematology Board and serves on the Board of Bloodworks Northwest in Seattle, where he was the founding chair of the Quality Advocacy Committee. He has served on multiple boards and was a long time member of the Rotary Club of Seattle.

Dr. Hammond is a graduate of Harvard College and the Tufts University School of Medicine in Boston, and completed his internship, residency and fellowship in hematology and medical oncology at the University of Washington in Seattle. His long-standing relationship with Bloodworks began more than 40 years ago when he received his training in blood banking from Bloodworks' founding Medical Director Dr. Elo Giblett.
