

Red Honor Cord Program

Seniors who register to donate blood four or more times during their high school or college career earn a red graduation cord to wear during commencement events* to be recognized for their commitment to providing life-saving donations. Donating blood is an opportunity for students to give back to the community.

- Seniors must complete the requirement by May 15 (or by the date of their school's final blood drive of the year).
- Students can qualify by registering to donate blood at any BWNW sponsored locations, including their school blood drive(s), community blood drives, or donor centers.
